APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 25900, Certificate 7799, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 25900, Certificate 7799 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.01105 cubic feet per second or 8.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 19 2013

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 19 2015

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

September 19 2015

White Pine County has acquired the well and place of use currently permitted under Permit 28628, Certificate 8475, from the State of Nevada. This property is the former NDOT rest stop and has a large grass area that is irrigated from an existing well. The State of Nevada does not wish to convey their water rights to White Pine County. White Pine County wishes to divert a portion of Permit 25900, Certificate 8475, for water rights to legally irrigate the existing large grass area.
