APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 79034, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 79034 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 79484, 79485, 81872, 81873, 81874, and 81875 shall not exceed 1501.4 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 300.28 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.079 cubic feet per second or 56.5 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

December 28 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



300.28 acres within: the SW¼SW¼ Section 18; W½NW¼, NW¼SW¼ Section 19, all in T. 3S., R. 61E., M.D.M., that portion of the SE¼SE¼ lying east of State Route 318 of Section 13; those portions of the NE¼ and the SE¼ lying east of State Route 318 of Section 24; NE¼, N¼SE¼ Section 25, all in T. 3S., R. 60E., M.D.M. All of this North Irrigation Area lies east of State Route 318, and contains Pivots 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8, as shown on accompanying supporting map.

37.6 acres within the SW¼SE¼, SE¼SE¼ Section 13; NW¼NE¼, NE¼NE¼ Section 24; all in T. 3S., R. 60E., MDM. This Application will remove 11.3 acres from irrigation from the existing place of use. Please refer to supporting map on file under Application 79034.
