APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61256, Certificate 15723 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61256, Certificate 15723 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.



An agreement has been reached between Humboldt County and BLM NV, Winnemucca District to utilize water from an existing well under the County's management to provide water for wild horses in the Jackson Mountain Herd Management Area (HMA). Water will be delivered via water tender to temporary storage tank and connected trough at a rate required to provide enough water for up to 200 wild horses per day (10 gal/ head/ day) until the planned Jackson Mountain HMA gather is completed.
