APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed.

The Permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 81915, 81916 and 81917, shall not exceed 200 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.33 cubic feet per second or 66.67 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 30 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



hereby make(s) application for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada, as hereinafter stated. (If applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation; if a copartnership or association, give names of members.)

The corporate charter of the Yomba Shoshone Tribe of Nevada was duly filed and ratified on December 22, 1939.

- 1. The source of water is underground.
2. The amount of water applied for is 0.33 cfs; 66.67 acre-feet annually.
3. The water is to be used for quasi-municipal purposes.

Supplemental Response to Question 12 (detailed description of proposed project and its water usage)

Water from this source will be used by Applicant to serve existing and future community facilities as well as to accommodate further development of that portion of the reservation included within the proposed place of use. As of the date of this application, the existing wells serve the Tribal Community complex consisting of 6 community buildings, including the administrative offices and school, as well as 10 – 12 residences. Anticipated uses include: domestic demands, irrigation demands of incidental lawn and landscaped areas as well as fire protection purposes. The total combined duty of Applications 81915, 81916 and 81917 shall not exceed 65 million gallons annually (200 acre-feet annually).

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
