This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the manner of use of the waters of an un-named spring as heretofore granted under Permit 46703 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 46703, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second or 144.7 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

October 30 2013

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



The water will be provided for the preservation and enhancement of fish and wildlife habitat. From the spring and wetland area water is flowing unimpeded in the natural stream channel. The spring supports mixed, coniferous/deciduous, and wet meadow area as well as a couple rare plant species.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

No improvements will be necessary to put the water to beneficial use under the proposed change of use. The spring freely flows out on to the landscape to provide water for wildlife and plant life. The improvements that existed under the permit were removed prior to purchase.
