APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 76983 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 76983 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed to measure all water pumped from this well. It must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for quasi-municipal purposes within the described place of use, further identified by the Clark County Assessor as APN 126-09-601-017, only. It is further understood that this permit was necessary, as required by Clark County Ordinance 30.52.100(b)(1), to provide the water for a domestic well right on APN 126-09-601-017 created by the subdivision of prior APN 126-09-601-004 and therefore no change in the place of use will be allowed.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.


