APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of Grapevine and Other Springs as heretofore granted under Permit 284, Certificate 527 Book 1, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 284, Certificate 527 Book 1 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The amount of water herein granted is limited to the amount of water actually produced by the spring, and no rights in excess of that amount are implied or inferred. A measuring device must be installed and measurements of water use kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The issuance of this permit abrogates the entire right under Permit 284, Certificate 527 Book 1.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 20.0 cubic feet per second or 41.3 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


