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**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68740 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68740 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 68739, 68740 and Temporary Permit 82049T shall not exceed 192.90 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.



An existing 6" well, 160 feet deep, which has been deepened. Well is cased at 5" from 160' to 500' per Well Log No. 113944.

This is an older well which the Applicant would like to use for a supplemental source to his irrigation system served primarily by the well under Permits 68739 and 68740. The well would be equipped to help this irrigation season and give the owner time to determine how to reliably deliver his irrigation water. This may involve a redrilling or deepening of his irrigation well or the longer term evaluation of the source under this application. In any case, the Applicant plans to submit a permanent application to accomplish his long term plan as soon as he can make the determination on his course of action.
