APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level.

A properly calibrated totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

Any application to change the point of diversion, place or manner of use granted under this permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation by the State Engineer.

It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is limited to the amount of water actually produced naturally by this mine adit source, and no rights in excess of that amount are implied or inferred.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



From mine adit through a 4" pipeline then split into two 2" diameter PVC pipelines; then (1) to a 6' diameter X 4' high steel storage tank with outlet pipe into an existing pond 40' X 80' X 8' deep with a 4' greenbelt/riparian (Cont. SEE 13.)

9. Estimated cost of works: N/A - Completed

10. Estimated time required to construct works: Existing - One Year

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: 5 years

12. Provide a detailed description of the proposed project and its water usage (use attachments if necessary): (Failure to provide a detailed description may cause a delay in processing.)

We owned 3.775 AFA of water under forfeited Permit # 46828, C. 11946. Serving an existing pond 40'X80'X8' deep. We recently measured flow at pipe discharge at 17 gpm in Spring 2011 but can flow at 20 gallons or more depending on season and water year snow pack. We need to maintain a water right on this source and our private property.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

Need water for domestic use for a single family residence and shop with landscaping (2.0 AFA) plus pond maintenance at 0.3 AFA., 25 wild horses at .6 AFA; local and migratory deer (25 animals) at 0.1 AFA and riparian habitat preservation at 0.3 AFA. (ET)

8. Continued - vegetation and habitat area, and 2nd pipe to a trough which then spills into the natural drainage.


