APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 63535, Certificate 15773 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 63535, Certificate 15773 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined consumptive duty of water under Permits 82096 and 82097 shall not exceed 4.794 acre-feet annually; however, additional duty up to a combined 5.1 acre-feet annually may be pumped if it can be shown that this additional duty will not cause the consumptive use amount to be exceeded.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is approved for the entire 3.076 acre-feet annually as requested. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703, initially only the net consumptive use amount of the base right, 2.891 acre-feet, can be diverted annually. Additional diversion up to the total 3.076 acre-feet may be granted if it can be shown that the additional diversion will not cause the consumptive use of 2.891 acre-feet to be exceeded.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

A total of 3.076 acre-feet annually is abrogated from the base right. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703 **only 2.891 acre-feet (the net consumptive use amount) at 0.0135 cubic feet per second cubic feet per second can be diverted annually. Additional duty up to the total may be granted if it can be shown that this additional duty will not cause the consumptive use amount to be exceeded.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 10 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


