APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 20861, Certificate 7145, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 20861, Certificate 7145 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of groundwater under Temporary Permits 82110T, 82111T and 82112T shall not exceed 1,145.5 acre feet annually for the irrigation of 229.1 acres of which a minimum of 174.2 acres must remain supplemental to those lands irrigated with surface water from Rose Valley Creek under Permit 82109T.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 2.2 cubic feet per second or 591.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed an annual duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:



Construction of pipelines and the installation of 2 pivots. The existing well under Permit 20833 will be used as a water source for the pipelines and pivots. The well was drilled to the depth of 207 feet. 14" O.D. casing was installed from 4' above ground service to total depth. The well is screened from 40' to total depth. This water will be commingled with other surface and groundwater for irrigation purposes.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

This temporary application is being filed to ensure the pivots will be able to be put into operation this year. A portion of this water is supplemental to water appropriated under Permit 11579 and 11060. It is anticipated an application for a permanent change will be filed. Surface water will be used to its fullest extent possible to efficiently irrigate the POU.
