APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 23089, Certificate 7453 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 23089, Certificate 7453 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 23088, Certificate 7452; Permit 24904, Certificate 8017; Permit 82117 and Permit 82118 having a commingled place of use shall not exceed 837.95 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second or 350.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 14 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






Well will be used for the irrigation of turf on an existing golf course.

Miscellaneous: The map for permit 23089 was incorrectly drawn as the PBU map shows the well being in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ while the permit describes the well as being in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$. The well was resurveyed with this application being filed to correct the point of diversion of the well drilled under Permit 23089. This discrepancy was found while preparing a temporary change application, which is being filed simultaneously with this change application. It is therefore requested that action be withheld on this change application to correct the point of diversion until the temporary permit has expired or is withdrawn by the applicant.
