APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 29349, Certificate 9786 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 29349, Certificate 9786 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 29350, Certificate 9787; Permit 30897, Certificate 9768; Permit 43066, Certificate 13730; and Permit 82166 shall not exceed the consumptive use amount of 55.66 acre feet annually. Additional duty up to 58.31 acre-feet annually may be diverted if it can be shown that this additional duty will not cause the consumptive use amount to be exceeded.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

A total of 26.32 acre-feet annually is abrogated from the base right. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703 **only 23.69 acre-feet (the net consumptive use amount) at 0.10 cubic feet per second can be diverted annually.** Additional duty up to the total may be granted if it can be shown that this additional duty will not cause the consumptive use amount to be exceeded.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 29 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


