APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18468, Certificate 7496 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18468, Certificate 7496 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 82211, 82212, 82213, 82214, 82215, 82216, 82217, 82218, 82219, 82220, 82221, 82222, 82223, 82224, 82225, 82226 and 82227 shall not exceed 9,237.30 acre feet annually for the irrigation of a maximum of 2,376.30 acres within the proposed place of use.

Permit 82211 is approved with the understanding that 109.63 acres are to remain supplemental to lands irrigated under the King's River Decree.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 82226 and 82227 shall not exceed 568.72 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of a maximum of 190.5 acres within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 6.0 cubic feet per second or 583.60 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 9 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


