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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of Trout Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 1561, Certificate 8912, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 1561, Certificate 8912, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 7050, Certificate 1917; Permit 7061, Certificate 1918; Permit 17577, Certificate 5771; Permit 20209, Certificate 6431; Permit 23444, Certificate 7788; Permit 23792, Certificate 7445; Permit 34408, Certificate 10271; Permit 34409, Certificate 10272; Permit 46257, Permit 55117, Certificate 13866; Claim of Vested Right V02905, and Permits 82236, 82237, and 82343 shall not exceed 2,096.25 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 546 acres.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.6 cubic feet per second or 336.45 acre-feet per season, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

August 29 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





This application is being requested with the understanding that the total combined duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.
