APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as set forth under Claim 3 in the Truckee River final decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is expressly contingent on the payment of the operation and maintenance charges that are properly assessed and come due in the same manner as if the water were still appurtenant to the agricultural land from which it is transferred, pursuant to NRS 533.370, subsection 1 (b).

This permit is subject to the allocation percentage during the season of the water rights of the Truckee Division of the Truckee Carson Irrigation District that is set for the season.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 106.11 acre-feet as decreed.**




