APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of the Miguel Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 1558, Certificate 229, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 1558, Certificate 229 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife which have customarily used such water will have access thereto, NRS 533.367.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.462 cubic feet per second or 168.61 acre-feet per season, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 23 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




