APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56825, Certificate 14163 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56825, Certificate 14163 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times but does not take responsibility for the use of the Federal range.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 82294 and 82295 shall not exceed 1.12 acre feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second or sufficient to water 50 head of horses, but not to exceed 1.12 acre-feet annually.**





The existing place of use for the total combined duty under Certificate Nos. 14163 and 14164 has been subdivided and a 10 acre parcel (Parcel 1, PM 497187) containing the well located in Section 20 (under Certificate No. 14164) was sold by the Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, which reserved all water and water rights including the underground rights designated under Certificate Nos. 14163 and 14164. The proposal is to divert all water through the existing well developed in Section 21 (under Certificate No. 14163) and to remove said 10 acre parcel from the existing place of use.
