APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 65865, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 65865 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 81135, 81145 through 81149, 82303, 82304, and 82307 through 82326 shall not exceed 2,951.57 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Pursuant to NRS 534.110(3), monthly records shall be kept of the effect of pumping this well on other previously existing wells that are located within 2,500 feet of this well and reported to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of the following year. Any pumping of water in this well may be limited or prohibited to prevent any unreasonable adverse effects on an existing domestic well located within 2,500 feet of this well, unless the holder of this permit and the owner of the domestic well have agreed to alternative measures that mitigate adverse effects.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of the each calendar quarter. The amount of water pumped for use in Douglas County Utilities northern service areas, and the amount for use in Carson City Utilities service area must be recorded and submitted as separate amounts.

The applicant shall provide a monitoring plan approved by the State engineer documenting the impact on water levels that may result from pumping under this permit.

The issuance of this permit fully abrogates Permit 65865.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.908 cubic feet per second or 203.348 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





The County will convey ownership of the existing water rights under this application to Minden upon notice by the Division of Water Resources of pending approval of the proposed change. Fully supplemental Permit 65866 will be withdrawn upon notice by the DWR of pending approval of this proposed change.


