### PERMIT TO CHANGE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF NEVADA HERETOFORE APPROPRIATED

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 19706, Certificate 6283, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 19706, Certificate 6283 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 18703, Certificate 5911; Permits 70911, 80301, and 82328 shall not exceed 326.4 acre-feet seasonally.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total land irrigated under Permit 18703, Certificate 5911; Permit 70911, Permit 80301 and Permit 82328 and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 240 acres. These permits for underground water are issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Numbers 149, and 96 of the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree. Underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree and storage water in any given year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.28 cubic feet per second or 87.4 acre-feet seasonally.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


