**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This secondary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of Buffalo Creek and its tributaries (Js-186 and Js-187) as heretofore granted under Primary Permit 82341, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Primary Permit 82341, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This permit is further issued subject to the provisions of NRS 533.440. A suitable measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water diverted from this source and the records shall be submitted to the State Engineer not later than April 30 of each year.

The total combined duty of surface water under Proofs of Appropriation V02934, V02935, V02936, V02937, V02938, and V02939 and Permits 82341-S01, 82342-S01, 83845, 84954, 85124, 85125, 85126, 85127, and 85128 shall not exceed 5,261.96 acre-feet per season for the irrigation of 1,395.49 acres within the described place of use.

The total combined duty of surface water under Proofs of Appropriation V02934, V02935, V02936, V02937, V02938, and V02939 and Permits 82341-S01, 82342-S01 and 83845 and supplemental groundwater under Permit 18496, Certificate 6412 and Permit 83844 shall not exceed 1,075.2 acre-feet per season for the irrigation of 268.8 acres within the described place of use.

This secondary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this secondary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second or 950.0 acre-feet per season.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

**January 30, 2018**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





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
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
