APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54205 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54205 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54204 and 82345 shall not exceed 2082.3 acre-feet annually and is supplemental to all surface water rights within the described place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

All surface water within the described place of use must be used for irrigation prior to the use of the ground water under Permits 54204 and 82345. Water under this permit is limited to the irrigation of 694.10 acres of previously irrigated land within the described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second or 2,082.3 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Permits 54204 and 54205 were issued with a total combined duty of 2,083.3 acre feet annually, not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from any and/or all sources. A well has been completed for Permit 54204 and is sufficient to supply the permitted duty and diversion rate for both permits. This change in point of diversion is intended to consolidate the two permits to a single point of diversion at the existing well that has been constructed under Permit 54204 and increase the diversion rate at that well.
