APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 30606, Certificate 9505, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 30606, Certificate 9505 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0464 cubic feet per second or 20.0 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed an annual duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre or land irrigated from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 26 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



Applicants propose to use an existing irrigation well (see Permit 30603) for the new point of diversion and construct a new pipeline to irrigated the proposed place of use. Annual consumptive use will not exceed 20 acre feet.

The former owner of Permit 30606 and of all the surrounding property, divided the property in 1996 according to the location of the existing building, not taking into account the location of the water rights or wells, and then deeded Permit 30606 to the applicants (Report of Conveyance has been filed). This application is being filed to correct the POU and POD.
