APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 70528, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 70528 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 54244, Certificate 15038; Permit 54245, Certificate 15037; Permits 76719, 82658 and 82659 shall not exceed 2081.32 acre-feet annually for industrial and irrigation purposes.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The Permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and all other Cyanco wells on the project and the records must be submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis on or before February 15th of the following year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 2.03 cubic feet per second or 784.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed an annual duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 27, 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




