APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of Robinson (Leidy) Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 70476 which changed the place of use of Permit 2889, Certificate 1881 of the Robinson (Leidy) Creek Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree, with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total acres irrigated on the northern portion of the ranch by permits 70164 through 70168, 70444 through 70457, 70459 through 70470, 70479 through 70481 and 82666 through 82670 shall be limited to 1,167.62 acres from surface sources, plus 1,363.46 acres from non-supplemental underground sources, for a total of 2,531.08 acres irrigated from all sources within the common described place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.16 cubic feet per second but not to exceed 585.0 acre-feet annually, and not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

February 7 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






