### PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

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#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

A portion of this permit is supplemental to 91.1 acres of surface water rights under Permit 25482, Certificate 7441.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second or 469.6 acre-feet annually but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

May 6 2016

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





38.4 acres within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 39.4 acres within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> and 39.6 acres within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 02, Township 14 North, Range 43 East, M.D.B.&M. Further described as APN 10-451-01, 10-451-02 and 10-451-03 (respectively), Nye County, Nevada.

Water will be diverted from a new well, with an electrical submersible pump and underground piping to irrigation system.

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: five (5) years

The water will be used to irrigate approximately 117.4 acres within the described place of use, a portion of which is supplemental to existing surface water rights appurtenant to permit 25482.

13. Miscellaneous remarks: 12.0 acres within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 39.4 acres within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, and 39.4 acres within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 02, Township 14 North, Range 43 East M.D.B.&M. are supplemental to existing surface water rights appropriated under permit 25482, certificate 7441. Note: Certificate 7441 indicates 39.7 acres within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 02, however a survey completed after the issuance of certificate 7441 indicates that there is only 39.4 acres within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of said Section 02.
