APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56599, Certificate 14207, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56599, Certificate 14207, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 82675 through 82683 and any water from the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 793.48 acre-feet per annually for the irrigation of 198.37 acres within the described place of use. This permit for underground water is issued as a supplemental water supply to land that has surface water rights and shall not exceed a duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre applied to the lands being irrigated from the total of decreed, storage, flood and underground waters.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit, for water from an underground source, is issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Numbers 45, 63, 84, 101, 106, 108, and 164 of the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. During times that underground water is utilized to supplement surface water, the total amount of water applied to the lands for irrigation from all sources shall not exceed the duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre for this place of use. Water from this permit shall not be pumped except to the extent necessary to make up the unavailable portion of the entitled duty from decree and storage water in any given year. The permit holder is responsible for ensuring delivery of the surface water from entitled decreed, flood and storage rights that this permit supplements. In any year that the Federal Water Master and the Walker River Irrigation District declare a full allocation of decreed and decree supplemental storage water to the priority years of these C-125 claims that this permit supplements, underground water under this permit shall not be pumped.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.183 cubic feet per second or 43.745 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:




