APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees and a portion of Permit 51040, Certificate 18886; and all of Permit 51048, Certificate 18887 which changed the place of use of a portion of the Newlands Reclamation Project rights in the Truckee and Carson River final decrees is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decrees and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued under the provisions of NRS 533.040 Paragraph 4 and is limited to the irrigation of 47.36 acres of land with a bottom land duty rate (3.5 acre-feet per acre) and 156.39 acres of land with a bench duty rate (4.5 acre-feet per acre) within the proposed place of use.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 869.51 acre-feet as decreed.**


Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: **N/A-Filed Under 62743 on June 25, 1998**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **September 13 2016**


