This permit, to change the point of diversion of Claim 709 of the Carson River as heretofore granted under the Final Carson River Decree No. D-183, in the District Court of the United States in and for the District of Nevada, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said Final decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed the amount as set forth in the Carson River Decree for the irrigation of 50.0 acres as decreed.**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





The Claim 709 Lloyd Ditch diversion dam was destroyed in 1951 by Carson River flooding, and related vested right claims were changed by Permit 14095 to a downstream sump pump (see Permit 14095 "Remarks"). Decree D-183 BRT subsequently issued in 1980 defines the ditch diversion for Claim 709 rights as "Lloyd", though the POD had been changed by Permit 14095. The Permit 14095 sump pump is no longer in use, and the Claim 709 POU can be irrigated through the Mexican Ditch. Permit 14095 is superceded by Claim 709, and will be withdrawn upon approval of this change application, and the sump pump and diversion dam removed.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

D-183 BRT Lloyd Ditch POD aliquot description NW¼ "BW¼" Sec. 35 is an error. Item #6 Existing POD under this change application, as suggested by discussion with Federal Water Master's Office, is based on POD description under Permit 14095, which had previously changed POD of undetermined vested right from Lloyd Dam to river pump station.
