**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 73313, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 73313 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued specifically for drip irrigation within the described place of use and is limited to the consumptive use portion, being 0.825 acre-feet annually.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

A total of 1.0 acre-foot annually is abrogated from the base right. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703 only 0.825 acre-feet (the net consumptive use amount) at 0.005 cubic feet per second can be diverted annually.


