APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and the place of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 191, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire **December 31, 2013**, after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is limited to the irrigation of 0.75 acres within the proposed place of use.

This temporary permit is subject to continuing jurisdiction by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.






