This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 73567, which changed the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Claim 269, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is under the continuing jurisdiction of the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0082 cubic feet per second or 1.5 acre-feet as decreed and limited to the irrigation of 0.375 acres within the proposed place of use.**



From Lake Ditch, a motor, pump, totalizing meter will be installed and water will be pumped directly from the ditch through a pipeline to an irrigation system within the proposed place of use.

12. Estimated cost of works \$5,000.00

13. Estimated time required to construct works Lake Ditch works - Completed

If well completed, describe well.

14. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use Five (5) Years

15. Provide a detailed description of the proposed project and its water usage (use attachments if necessary): (Failure to provide a detailed description may cause a delay in processing.)

Water will be diverted from the Lake Ditch via a pump and pipeline. A totalizing meter will be installed and meter readings will be sent on a monthly basis to both the Federal Water Master and the Lake Ditch Company. The irrigation system will consist of pvc piping and drip lines within the place of use. The proposed Lake Ditch diversion is based on meetings with the ditch riders from both the Lake Ditch and Last Chance Ditch.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

The existing Decreed water right within the place of use, shown under Truckee River Decree Claim No. 179, was reserved by Document No. 2782813, recorded in the office of the Washoe County Recorder on December 18, 2002 (submitted with this application). This right is not owned or utilized by the current property owner.

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**EXHIBIT "A"**

The following describes the multiple points of diversion for Truckee Meadows Water Authority Water Treatment Plants, which are shown on the map accompanying Application No. 71606 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources, more particularly described as follows:

**STEAMBOAT CANAL (HUNTER CREEK RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 31 bears South 62°04' East, a distance of 3,195.00 feet.

**HIGHLAND DITCH (HIGHLAND RESERVOIR):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 9 bears South 75°16' East, a distance of 1,650.00 feet.

**IDLEWILD TREATMENT PLANT:**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Southeast corner of said Section 10 bears South 69°57'58" East, a distance of 842.34 feet.

**NORTH TRUCKEE DITCH (GLENDALE TREATMENT PLANT):**

The existing point of diversion is situate within the Southwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion, the Northeast corner of said Section 7 bears North 39°28' East, a distance of 3,015.00 feet.

**ORR DITCH PUMP STATION (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

The point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southeast one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion the Northeast corner of said Section 17 bears North 15°39'36" East, a distance of 3,264.77 feet.

**ORR DITCH (CHALK BLUFF TREATMENT PLANT):**

The point of diversion is situate within the Northeast one-quarter of the Southwest one-quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., Washoe County, Nevada, from said point of diversion the Southwest corner of said Section 17 bears South 44°40' West, a distance of 3,211.00 feet.
