APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 11876, Certificate 3503 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 11876, Certificate 3503 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 11876, Certificate 3503; Permit 36870, Certificate 12923; Permit 36871, Certificate 13747; Permit 36872, Certificate 13748; Permit 49459, Certificate 14023; Permit 49461, Certificate 14025; Permit 52036, Certificate 14018; Permit 54214, Certificate 13754; Permits 65411, 65412, 65415 through 65427, 65428E, 65429E, 68408, 76196, 76283, 80306 and 82822T shall not exceed 12,905 acre-feet annually.

Monthly records shall be kept of the following and reported within 15 days after the end of each quarter:

- A. The total volume of water pumped from this well in acre-feet.
- B. The maximum flow rate from this well in cubic feet per second.
- C. The volume of water consumptively used for mining and milling in acre-feet.
- D. The amount of water diverted to other consumptive uses, if any, in acre-feet.
- E. The amount of water lost through evaporation or other system losses project wide.

The State Engineer retains the right to require the permittee cooperate in the funding of additional monitoring and modeling by an independent third party. The State Engineer retains the right to impose future conditions as necessary upon review and evaluation of all data submitted. The State Engineer retains the right to regulate pumping herein authorized to protect the public interest and existing rights.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.268 cubic feet per second or 917.994 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:




