APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 65118, Certificate 16465 and Permit 82854 shall not exceed 4.48 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

Permit 65118, Certificate 16465 and Permit 82854 are issued for commercial purposes within the described place of use further described by the Washoe County Assessor as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 079-382-53 and 079-382-54. Any future changes of place of use or manner of use will be subject to additional analysis.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.15 cubic feet per second or 4.0 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 30 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





5. The water is to be diverted from its source at the following point: (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey, and by course and distance to a found section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated.)

At a point within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 8, T. 22N., R. 19 E., M.D.M., from which the southeast corner of said Section 8 bears South 39degrees 20'48" East, 2,551' distant.

6. Place of use: (Describe by legal subdivision. If on unsurveyed land, it should be so stated)

The Place of use is APN 79-382-53, 12.09 acres and APN 79-382-54, 38.22 acres within portions of the SE 1/4 Section 8, T. 22 N., R. 19 E. M.D.B.& M.

7. Use will begin about January 1 and end about December 31 of each year.

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 600 feet deep, 6-5/8 inch diameter casing, equipped with a Grundfos 6-SQF-3 solar pump, thence to a 5,000 gallon poly storage tank.

9. Estimated cost of works: \$24,600 for solar pumping system, tank and water line

10. Estimated time required to construct works: Six months: Tank and solar panel installation. (Well is complete)

11. Estimated time required to complete the application of water to beneficial use: One year

We ask that the State please consider that our existing well only produces 2.5gpm and practically stops producing after about 5 hours and that we are asking little more than what two parcels with domestic wells are allowed by law.
