Pond and water source are already established. Pond will provide resources to benefit wildlife and provide fishing opportunities for the public. BLM will conduct maintenance of area surrounding pond to include fishing deck. The out-flow will be maintained to provide for the riparian habitat which is adjacent to the pond, and the current flow and level of the spring is required to provide for fisheries and recreation.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

Pond is located at the center of the Sacramento Pass Recreation Site. Pond was developed in early 1990's by a mining crew, BLM took over responsibility in 1995. Included is a map used from a previous application #58163. Livestock will not be accessing the pond. Area permittee is fenced off from recreation site.


