APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 22479, Certificate 6819, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 22479, Certificate 6819, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water and a totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is also issued subject to the provision that the place of use of the water herein granted is limited to and supplemental to lands having existing water rights under Truckee River Claim 185 (Washoe County APN 040-650-17) and Claim 186 (Washoe County APN 040-650-24).

The total combined duty of water under Permit 61443, Certificate 17138 and Permit 82968 shall not exceed 8.75 acre-feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0216 cubic feet per second or 3.15 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed a duty of 4.25 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

November 4 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




