APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 81619 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 81619 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the Proof of Completion of Work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit is issued pursuant to the Settlement Agreement dated April 1, 2010 between the State Engineer and Lincoln County Water District and Vidler Water Company.

The initial amount of water granted under this permit is limited to 2,900 acre-feet annually with the initial total combined duty of water under this permit and Permit 66932, not to exceed 5,000 acre-feet annually. The District and Vidler shall implement a staged aquifer pumping test that shall consist of a minimum of eight consecutive years whereby pumping must average at least 2,500 acre feet annually, and in no year shall pumping be less than 2,000 acre feet annually. Additional water under this permit may be granted conditioned upon a favorable analysis by the State Engineer of the aquifer test results, ground water model predictions and associated hydrologic study data as outlined in the Settlement Agreement.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second or 7,240.0 acre-feet annually, and is initially limited to 2,900 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

July 14, 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




