APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of the waters of The Beaver Dam Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 70285, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 70285, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 7508, Certificate 1857; Permit 70286, Permit 70999 and Permit 83028 shall not exceed 215 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 43 acres within the described place of use. Drain and waste water from these permits must be returned to Beaver Dam Creek.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 5.5 cubic feet per second or 215 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a yearly duty of 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.**


Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: **Filed Under 70285 on March 05, 2012**

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: **April 23 2015**


