APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 32318, Certificate 13193 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 32318, Certificate 13193 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening and a weir or other type of measuring device at or near the well to facilitate the measurement and control of the water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.89 cubic feet per second or 188.48 acre-feet annually and not to exceed an annual duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**





The lands to be irrigated are currently irrigated from co-mingled springs which are drying up due to drought conditions in the area. It is proposed to drill a new well and utilize the existing permitted water temporarily from Permit 32318 to irrigate existing agricultural lands.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:


This is being done due to the back log of water permits caused by SNWA filings in the area, time being very important to allow the ranch to continue to exist as permitted springs are providing less water than permitted for and required. Without this temporary change of existing permitted water, the lands will be lost to drought causing a sever hardship for the ranch.
