#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place and manner of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61473, Certificate 14452 is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61473, Certificate 14452 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

This permit is issued subject to the provision that a portion of the place of use of the water herein granted may be supplemental to lands having an existing vested claim to McLeod Creek under V05777.

The total combined duty of water under a portion of Permit 16847, Certificate 4666; Permit 16848, Certificate 4667; Permit 40007, Certificate 14451; Permit 83146 and Permit 83147 shall not exceed 351.68 acre-feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.602 cubic feet per second or 147.07 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 17 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


