APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 68948, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 68948 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 60576, 60607, 60608, 60609, 60611, Certificate 15122; Permits 60612, 60613, Certificate 15123; Permit 60614, Certificate 15395; Permit 60615, Certificate 15124; Permits 64626, 64627, 65007, 70338, 70339, 70440, 83293 and 83294 shall not exceed 6,147.33 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

A total of 0.134 acre-feet annually is abrogated from the base right. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703 **only 0.100 acre-feet (the net consumptive use amount) at 0.0005 cubic feet per second can be diverted annually.** Additional duty up to the total may be granted if it can be shown that this additional duty will not cause the consumptive use amount to be exceeded.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 13 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






