#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 12064, Certificate 3596; is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 12064, Certificate 3596 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The water under Permit 83337 and Permit 83339 is commingled and the total combined duty shall not exceed 383.18 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 86.13 acres within the proposed place of use.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The total amount of water that may be diverted from the well under Permit 74608, Certificate 18212; Permit 76927, Certificate 18213; Permit 83337 and Permit 83339 shall not exceed 1,179.18 acre-feet annually.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.45 cubic feet per second or 218.46 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





44.95 acres are being removed from Permit 12064, Certificate 3596 and are being transferred to an existing irrigation well and combined with other underground water rights to irrigate the place of use. Annual consumptive use will not exceed 179.80 acre feet.
