This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of Spring Creek and East Spring Creek, as heretofore appropriated under Proof V01414 as appears in the Goose Creek Decree, dated March 3, 1923, in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Nevada, in and for the County of Elko, is issued subject to the terms, conditions and irrigation period imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.73 cubic feet per second or 202.7 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





This application is being filed to achieve compliance with the requirements of the Notice of Alleged Violation AV 71. The Plan for Implementing Corrective Actions of Alleged Violation VA 71 Trout Creek Ranches, LLC, approved October 2, 2013.

The waters from the creek are stored in a storage reservoir. From the reservoir water is conveyed by an outlet pipe from the reservoir into a pipeline that delivers water to the area being irrigated and shown as the proposed place of use.


16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Even though this application states that it is changing the point of diversion of a portion of Proof 01414 this may or may not be the case. The position of the existing point of diversion could not be ascertained from the Goose Creek Decree or the maps that accompanied the Decree. The point of diversion shown on this application and the map to accompany this application is the point at which water is diverted from the outlet pipe of the storage reservoir to the pipeline that serves water to the area being irrigated and shown as the proposed place of use under this application.
