APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of Lake Tahoe as heretofore granted under Permit 45786, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 45786 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein.

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the right herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to a beneficial use. A totalizing meter must be installed in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to a beneficial use. This permit is subject to the final allocation of the State of Nevada under the California-Nevada Interstate Compact. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.03875 cubic feet per second or 16.24 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




