This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place of use of a portion of the waters of The Squaw Valley Creek as heretofore granted under Permit 13943, Certificate 5588, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 13943, Certificate 5588, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A substantial headgate and measuring device must be installed and maintained to facilitate the measurement and control of water. The State reserves the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.225 cubic feet per second or 60.0 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.





Water will be released from Squaw Creek Reservoir, flow down the channel of Squaw Valley Creek, pass through the Dean Ditch diversion and continue down Squaw Valley Creek to the place of use. Alternatively water may be diverted through the Dean Ditch and then be taken out at the place of use as it crosses the Christopher's property.


