APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 20439, Certificate 6088, Permit 20440, Certificate 6089, Permit 20443, Certificate 6092, Permit 20445, Certificate 6170, Permit 20446, Certificate 6083, Permit 59641, Certificate 15441; Permit 76762, Certificate 18349; Permit 77246, Certificate 18350; Permit 78909, Certificate 18352; Permit 78910, Certificate 18353; Permit 80391, Certificate 19209; Permit 80392, Certificate 19210; Permit 80393, Certificate 19211; Permit 80948, Certificate 19327; and Permit 83350 shall not exceed 44.8 acre-feet annually or sufficient to water 2,000 cattle.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0619 cubic feet per second, sufficient to water 2,000 head of cattle, but not to exceed 44.8 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 28 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




