APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to NRS 533.504 and is subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 59196, Certificate 14801, Permit 59198, Certificate 14802, Permit 59199, Permit 68032, Certificate 16555, Permit 68033, Certificate 16556, Permit 70068, Certificate 17311, Permit 82175, Permit 82176, Permit 82177, Permit 82895, Permit 83325T, Proof V07663, Proof V10434, Proof V10435 and Proof V010436 shall not exceed 11.2 acre feet annually.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle, but not to exceed 11.2 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 1, 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



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
