**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 78455, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 78455 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 78454, 78455, 78456 & 83543T shall not exceed 640.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 160 acres.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The well must be constructed to such a depth that it minimizes the potential impact to surface water springs near the point of diversion. The proposed well design must be approved by the State Engineer.

This permit is issued as a supplemental right to Claim of Vested Right V02192, and any other surface water right appurtenant to the described place of use, and groundwater is only to be used when there is no surface water available.

Additional monitoring may be required to determine potential impacts to existing rights.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.125 cubic feet per second or 40.0 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:


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


