APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, for diversion rate only (no additional volume of water), is issued subject to existing rights. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the amount of water actually placed to beneficial use. It is also understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer, pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water granted herein at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The well must be sealed with cement grout, concrete grout or neat cement from ground level to 100 feet.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

This permit for underground water is issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water, flood water and underground water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total land irrigated under Permit 19750, Certificate 5927; Permit 24013, Certificate 8286; Permit 30068, Certificate 10419; Permit 30263, Certificate 10703; Permit 30521, Certificate 10423; Permit 68309, Permit 68310, Permit 68311 and Permit 83574 and any water of the Walker River Decree and any storage water appurtenant to the place of use shall not exceed 4,083.2 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 1,020.8 acres within the described place of use.

These permits for underground water are issued as a supplemental water supply to lands that have surface water rights from the Walker River as set forth in Claim Numbers 1, 34, 70, 78, 113, 144 and 153 of the Walker River Decree C-125, or from storage water provided from the Walker River Irrigation District. The total diversion of water for irrigation from any and all sources shall not exceed the duty of water for this place of use as set forth in the Decree. Underground water shall not be pumped from the wells described in these permits except to the extent necessary to make up the portion of the entitled duty from Decree and storage water in any given year.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 7.0 cubic feet per second or 4,083.8 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



This permit would increase and supplement the diversion rate of water for irrigation and domestic purposes under P19750 C5927, P68309, P68310, P68311, P24013 C8286, P30068 C10419, P30263 C10703, & P30521 C10423 without any increase in the annual duty allowed under these permits per Amendment to Chapter 533.125 of NRS per SB 468.


