#### APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 48994, Certificate 12358; Permit 52581, Certificate 13010; Permit 59805, Certificate 15864; Permit 59806, Certificate 15865; Permit 59807, Certificate 15866; Permit 59808, Certificate 15867 and Permit 83591 shall not exceed the amount sufficient to water 2,700 head of cattle, but not to exceed 60.48 acre-feet annually.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0309 cubic feet per second, sufficient to water 1,000 head of cattle, but not to exceed 22.4 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

June 17 2015

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:






Applicant proposes to use an existing well to provide water for up to 1000 head of cattle. The applicant currently has 6 additional stock water permits that are certificated for up to 2700 head of cattle (Permits 48994, 52581, 59805, 59806, 59807 & 59808), applicant proposes to have the existing permits to be modified along with the new application to be limited to 1000 head of cattle not to exceed 22.40 acre feet annually from all sources.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

There have been 2 additional applications filed on this well (44852 & 76366), the well was drilled in 1958 and has been used for stock watering ever since. The applicant holds the grazing rights from the BLM for this grazing allotment. Please use the map for Permit 44852, for the proposed point of diversion and place of use.
